### **Easter Baskets**

- We will have 24 Easter baskets that will be available to the lucky 24 children that show up first. These baskets may contain some special goodies and are on a first come first served basis.

### **Photo Booth**

- There will be an Easter back drop and inflatable Bunny for taking photos (located at 10416 Brighton) Bring your own camera. Back drop will be available during whole event.

### **Crafts**

- Crafting will be open to all starting at 4pm. Please take others into consideration when crafting, so there will be plenty to go around (located at 10416 Brighton) An example of crafting supplies that will be available are acrylic paints, white glue, hot glue, small pieces, felt, wood, ribbon, Etc.

### **Coloring Contest**

- Important: Do not write your names on the front of the sheets. They will be displayed for voting during the event.

- The coloring contest will start on March 16, 2024 and ends on March 23, 2024 during the event. You can download and print your own coloring sheets from our website at [NisquallyMeadowsHOA.com](http://NisquallyMeadowsHOA.com), or you can pick up pre-printed contest sheets at 10416 Brighton.

- The contest is open to all ages and the entries will be voted on at the craft area, on the day of event. There may be a couple special prizes, depending on how many participate in the event.

- You don't have to be present to win.

### **Easter Egg Hunts**

- Please bring your own basket or receptacle to collect your eggs. If you are one of the first 24 children as described above, you may not need to bring a basket!

- Egg hunters can participate in multiple egg hunts if hunt rules allow (based on ages)

- Collect as many eggs as possible and then take your eggs to the crafting area to have your eggs counted. Prizes will be given out at end of the day for the person that collected the most eggs in each hunt.

- You don't have to be present to win

### **Easter Egg Hunt Rules (all hunts)**

1. No picking up eggs until the event coordinator says you can start. If you've already spotted a few eggs, remember where they are so you can grab them once the hunt starts.

2. We did set up age groups, but also please be fair to the younger children, so they can get to the easy ones. We will be laying some eggs on the ground out in the open for the youngsters. Don't worry there will be tougher eggs to look for that will be hidden in clever, and hard-to-reach spots for you bigger boys and girls. So, if you're on the older side, leave the easy ones and go put your skills to the test!

3. No fighting over eggs! This event is designed for everyone to have a great time. If you can't decide who gets the egg, then ask an adult for help.

4. The egg hunt boundary will be clearly explained, so you know where to look and be safe outside of the roads or other dangerous areas.
5. The eggs found with a number written on them, can be redeemed for a special prize at 10416 Brighton.
6. Please do not litter. Please throw away your trash or pick up any items on the ground from the event to help keep our neighborhood looking nice.
7. Please return any eggs you wish not to keep to the egg return bin.

### **Rules for Parents:**

Please try to limit to one parent per child in the 1–4 year old section

Parents are NOT allowed to pick up eggs, except during the glow hunt

No parents allowed in Hunt 2 and 3

Please monitor your little as they open eggs. There will be small toys and candy that could present a choking hazard if unsupervised.

### **Coloring Contest**

Important: Do not put your name on the front of the picture. The pictures will be put on display for voting during the event.

1. All entrants must be at least 3 years old.
2. All entrants must color one of the three pictures provided to enter.
3. Only one entry per participant.
4. Entrants may pick up a picture anytime between March 16 and March 23 at 10416 Brighton St SE, or download at [Nisquallymeadowshoa.com](http://Nisquallymeadowshoa.com)
5. All completed entries must be received at 10416 Brighton St SE by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 to qualify.
6. Pictures must be colored with crayons, colored pencils, markers, or any combination of.
7. Entries will be voted on by community members.

9. Voting criteria will be creativity, coloring skill, and overall appearance.
